(John 1:17) The Lord is our Savior [Holman, Page 190, JBQ #330]

(John 1:29) Jesus Christ would be the perfect and sinless sacrifice, paying the full penalty of sin once and for all. By His death, Jesus broke the power of guilt and sin and opened the way to God for all who accept Jesus as Forgiver of their sins and Leader of their lives.

(John 3:1)      Nicodemus    [JBQ #188]

(John 3:3,5)      Those who repent by admitting their sins and turning away from their own way; turning to God and entrusting Jesus to be the Forgiver of their sins and Leader of their lives.

(John 4:3-26) The Samaritans were the descendents of the Jews who were not carried captive to Babylon. They intermarried with the Gentiles around them and corrupted the worship of God with pagan gods and idols. Because of this they were rejected by the Jews. [Holman, page 315]

In talking with the Samaritan woman, what two social customs did Jesus violate?

(John 4:9) A man talking to a woman in public  
A Jew talking with a Samaritan [CBL, page 87]

What does it mean to worship God in truth?

(John 4:23,24) To adore God as the Father in accordance with Jesus, the Living Word, and the Bible, the written word. [CBL, page 97]

What is one of the results of both miraculous signs and wonders?

(John 4:48) Signs and wonders should strengthen and deepen our faith and devotion to the Lord. [FBSE, page 1457]

There was a man who was an invalid for thirty eight yars. Why should we not give up hope for receiving a healing?

(John 5:5) While we may not understand why relief or a miracle do not come, never give up that hope God’s perfect time to work a miracle in your life may come soon. [FBSE, page 1457]

In the kingdom of God, what purposes do miracles serve?

(John 6:2)      Honor Jesus and prove the truth of His message and His identity as God's Son and our Saviour

Express Christ's compassionate love

Signify the opportunity for salvation and the coming of the kingdom of God to invade and overpower the kingdom of Satan.      [FBSE, page 1460]

What is the significance of Jesus' "I am the bread of life" saying?

(John 6:51)      I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

What did the Feast of Tabernacles commemorate?

(John 7:2)      God's provision for Israel when they lived in tents during their wandering in the desert following the exodus from Egypt.      [FBSE, page 1462]

What two questions help us test whether a person is truly serving God?

(John 7:18)      Do they work for their own glory; trying to advance their own position and promote their own purposes?

Or do they humbly work to bring honor to God, regardless of the cost to them or to their reputations?      [FBSE, page 1463]

Jesus said Scripture stated that streams of living water would flow from within believers. Why is this not underlined in the portion as an Old Testament Scripture?

(John 7:38)      Jesus was not directly quoting from a specific passage but rather from a composite of several references.

(Specifically, see Joel 3:18, Zechariah 14:8, and Ezekiel 47:1-12)      [CBL, page 211]

**Question\_\_for 20 points. Application Question. Scripture text question. Give a complete answer.**

What did John mean when he wrote, quote, “Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified?”

(John 7:39)            Although the Holy Spirit has been eternally active, Jesus had to complete His work on earth before the Holy Spirit could begin His full work in the Church.    *[FBSE, page 1464]*

**Question\_\_for 20 points. Application Question. Give a complete answer.**

How was Jesus glorified?

(John 7:39)            Through His sacrificial death on Calvary and His resurrection from the dead.  
*[FBSE, page 1464]*

**Question\_\_for 30 points. Application Question. Give two complete answers.**

In what different circumstances did Jesus declare himself to be The Light of the World?

(John 8:1-12)        The moral darkness of both the woman caught in adultery and her accusers

(John 9:5)            The physical darkness of the man born blind    *[CBL, pages 227 and 259]*

**Question\_\_for 30 points. Application Question. Two part question. Give a complete answer.**

In the incident of the woman caught in adultery, why did the Pharisees think they had Jesus “trapped” if He answered, “Stone her,” or if He answered, “Do not stone her”?

(John 8:5,6)        If Jesus said to stone her, they could report him to the Roman officials since they were the only ones who could execute anyone in Palestine.  
If Jesus said not to stone her, they could tell the Jewish people that Jesus did not believe in the Law of Moses.    *[CBL, page 221]*

According to John 8:42, what is one great proof that a person is a child of God?

(John 8:42)        Love for Jesus    *[FBSE, page 1467]*

**Question\_\_for 10 points. Application Question. Give a complete answer. From John chapter 8.**

According to verse 44, what is one great proof that one is a child of the devil?

(John 8:44)        An indifferent attitude toward lying.    *[FBSE, page 1467]*

**Question\_\_for 20 points. Application Question. Give a complete answer.**

What did the statement “before Abraham was born, I am!” express?

(John 8:58)        Jesus did not say “I was” but “I am” expressing his eternal nature.    *[FBSE 1467]*

**Question\_\_for 20 points. Application Question. Give a complete answer. From John chapter 8.**

When Jesus said, “Before Abraham was, I am,” why did the Jews consider it blasphemy?

(John 8:58,59)    “I Am” was the title God used to introduce himself to Moses at the burning bush.  
*[FBSE 1467]*

Which of Jesus’ healings proves that illness is not necessarily punishment for some act of sin?

(John 9:1-5)        Healing of the man born blind    *[GE]*

In the illustration of the sheep pen, who are those who do not enter by the gate?

(John 10:1,8)       False leaders    *[CBL, page 285]*

**Question\_\_for 10 points. Application Question. Statement and question. Give a complete answer.**

Jesus said that those who do not enter the sheepfold by the gate are thieves and robbers.

(John 10:8) All who ever came before Jesus [CBL, page 285]

**Question\_\_for 10 points. Application Question. Give a complete answer. From John chapter 10.**

Who are the “other sheep” whom Jesus would also bring?

(John 10:16) Believers among the Gentiles [CBL, page 291]

Did the Jews or the Gentiles kill Jesus?

(John 10:18) Neither. Jesus said, “I lay [my own life] down of my own accord. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. [GE]

What did the Feast of Dedication commemorate?

(John 10:22) Dedication, or Hannukah, commemorated the rededication of the temple after Judas Maccabeus defeated a Syrian king who had mocked God by offering a hog on the temple altar. The Jewish people again dedicated the temple to the worship of God. [CBL, page 295 and BBC, page 128]

John presents carefully selected evidence that Jesus was Israel’s Messiah and God’s Son. What seven main signs are listed in John?

(John 11:1-46)	Water into wine	(John 2:1-12)

(John 11:52) Scattered children of God [CBL, page 335]

What were the purposes of the Triumphal Entry?

(John 12:12-19) By His entry into Jerusalem riding on a donkey, Jesus publicly showed that He was Israel’s promised King and Messiah. Jesus’ humble entry showed that He did not come with force or violence, demonstrating that His kingdom is spiritual [FBSE, pages 1425 and 1473]

(John 12:14) Zechariah 9:9 [CBL, page 347]

**Question\_\_for 10 points. Application Question.**

Which Old Testament king best symbolized Jesus' kingship?

(John 12:15) David [CBL, page 347]

**Question\_\_for 30 points. Application Question. Essence question.**

Give in essence the verse which declares that spiritual fruitfulness and effectiveness is through suffering and death.

(John 12:24) I tell you the truth, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only single seed. But, if it dies, it produces many seeds. [FBSE, Page 1473]

(John 12:25) To love Jesus more than our life [CBL, page 353—See also Matthew 10:37]

What did Jesus mean when He spoke of being "lifted up"?

(John 12:33) The kind of death He was going to die, crucifixion on a cross [CBL, page 359]

**Question\_\_for 20 points. Application Question. Give a complete answer.**

Why was the "Last Supper" the last true Passover ever observed?

(John 13:1) Because Jesus fulfilled the Passover when He offered His own body upon the cross as the "once and for all" sacrifice for human sin. Our observance of the "Lord's Supper" is to commemorate His sacrifice, not to offer a new sacrifice as the Israelites had.  
[CBL, page 339 & GE]

(John 13:1-17) He washed the disciples' feet [JBQ #212]

To symbolically forecast His self-sacrifice on the cross  
To convey the truth that those who follow Him must humbly serve one another
