



National Memorization Award Guidelines

The following guidelines are for the 2010-2011 Bible Quiz season over the Gospel of John:

1. The National Memorization Award is available to quizzers, grades 6-12, and to all Bible Quiz coaches and officials. The National Memorization Award rules and guidelines apply to **all participants** (quizzers, coaches, and officials) who are working on their 2010 - 2011 National Memorization Award.
2. The coach or official to whom the quizzer quotes must not be a parent or family member. If the coach or official is a parent or family member of the quizzer, the quizzer must quote to another coach or official in the church. In the event that the parent or family member is the only Bible Quiz coach or official in the church, the quizzer may quote to their youth pastor, youth sponsor, senior pastor, league coordinator, district coordinator, or another adult who has a firm understanding of the quoting rules.
3. All quizzers must quote **an entire chapter at one sitting**, to a Bible Quiz coach or official.
4. The quizzer is permitted four mistakes per chapter. Each word that is omitted, repeated, added, or changed counts as one mistake. If a quizzer corrects himself or herself, the correction still counts as a mistake.
5. The quizzer may quote the entire chapter as many times as necessary by **March 3, 2011**, to quote within the four-mistake limit.
6. Each quizzer must quote at least one entire chapter during a Sunday morning, Sunday evening, or Wednesday evening service in their local church. The chapter may have been previously quoted to a coach (youth pastor, etc) so that the number of mistakes in the pulpit will not hinder their award. Coaches should set the service date with the senior pastor on the church calendar early in 2010-2011 season.
7. Quizzers in grades 6 through 12 who compete in the "A" League during the 2010-2011 season must quote the entirety of John. Quizzers in grades 6 through 8 who compete in the Middle School League are only required to quote John chapters 1-8. Quizzers in grades 6-12 who are competing in the "B" League ("C" League, etc.) over the Middle School material are also only required to quote John chapters 1-8. However, both Middle School and "B" League ("C" League, etc.) may also quote the entire Gospel of John if they so desire. Quizzers competing in a "B" League ("C" League, etc.) covering the "A" League material must quote the entire Gospel of John to be eligible for this award.
8. **All "B" League ("C" League, etc.) and Middle School quizzers who move up to the "A" division for official competition will be considered "A" League quizzers, and therefore must quote the Gospel of John in its entirety in order to receive their National Memorization Award.**
9. Only students who complete the "A" League National Memorization Award, covering all of John, will be eligible for Bible Quiz National Memorization Award scholarships offered through many Assemblies of God colleges and universities. Students who earn the Middle School or "B" League Memorization Award will **NOT** be eligible for scholarships from the national office or from any Assembly of God college or university (unless specified by that college or university).
10. All National Memorization guidelines must be met in order to be eligible for the Master Memorization Award. Please see MMA guidelines for more information.
11. Only the official National & Master Memorization Award form will be accepted. These forms must be postmarked or faxed no later than **March 3, 2011**. There will be no exceptions for forms that are postmarked or faxed after the deadline. Any non-official forms and/or any forms received after the deadline will be returned to the church or coach and an award will not be issued.
